

The Waterloo Economic Mobility Hub is a collaborative initiative designed to empower individuals and families in Waterloo by providing comprehensive resources and support for financial and economic stability. This innovative hub brings together key partners, including The Job Foundation, which focuses on financial literacy and youth empowerment; The Bank of Jabez, offering tailored financial services and community banking solutions; ONE Cedar Valley, driving workforce readiness and economic inclusion; and Iowa Legal Aid, providing accessible legal services to remove barriers to economic mobility. Together, these entities create a unified platform to address systemic challenges and foster pathways to prosperity for all members of the community.



The Community

Nestled within the historic St. John's Campus, this transformative initiative breathes new life into the Northside of Waterloo. Additionally, it delivers critical resources and is strategically located just steps away—less than two blocks—from essential services like Operation Threshold, the Food Bank, and the Women's Center for Change.
